BalletCNJ Year Round is designed for the more serious student that is looking to make great improvements in technique and artistry. Students are guided toward the path that will prove most beneficial and that is tailored to their needs.

Students (ages 3-9) are part of the Young Dancer Division. Placement is based according to age.

Students (ages 10+) are part of the Dancer Division. Placement is based according to skill level.

New students registering for the year round program are required to have an assessment class to determine proper class placement. New students registering late may contact the studio for a scheduled assessment class.

Philosophy of Training

BalletCNJ believes in a challenging progression of training that inspires students to reach their true potential and go far beyond. Young Dancer Division students (ages 3-9) are placed according to their age in order to allow for proper physical development through these crucial young years. Dancer Division students (ages 10+) are placed according to their skill level and knowledge of dance. After transitioning into Dancer Division, BalletCNJ encourages students to further specialize in a style of dance of their choosing while still keeping a strong focus on developing ballet technique and artistry. Class Attire Guidelines (Young Dancer Division)

Creative Movement and Pre-Ballet

Girls: Pink tights and ballet shoes that match. Leotards must be pink. Hair must be worn in a neat bun. No leotards with attached skirts.

Boys: Black shoes and black tights with a fitted white t-shirt.

Ballet I

Girls: Pink tights and ballet shoes that match. Leotard must be black of simple design. Hair must be worn in a neat bun. Proper color elastic waist belt is required for every class. Please, look below for elastic color and level.

Boys: Black shoes and black tights with a fitted white t-shirt.

Jazz I

Girls: Black sheer tights and black jazz shoes. Leotard must be black. Hair must be neat and away from the face (bun is not necessary).

Boys: Black jazz pants and black jazz shoes with a fitted white t-shirt.

Class Attire Guidelines (Dancer Division)

Ballet II, III, IV, Pointe & Pas de Deux

Girls: Pink tights and ballet shoes that match. Leotards must be black of simple design. Pointe shoes must be sewn with ribbons. Hair must be worn in a neat bun. Proper color elastic waist belt is required for every class. Please, look below for elastic color and level. No tights are to be worn over leotard. No ballet skirts, warmups nor jewelry are allowed.

Boys: Black shoes and black tights. A form fitting white shirt is required for class. No loose shirts nor warmups are allowed.

Character

Girls: Pink tights and black leotard. Black character skirt (24" in length). Black character shoes with 1.5" heel.

Boys: Black tights and form fitting white shirt. Black character shoes or black jazz shoes.

Jazz & Modern

Girls: Black sheer tights and black jazz shoes. Colored leotards are allowed. No warmups or loose fitting attire are allowed.

Boys: Black jazz pants and black jazz shoes. Tight fitted shirt of any color. No warmups or loose fitting attire are allowed.

Waist elastics are available for purchase at the front desk. Please, make sure you have yours prior to starting classes!

Registration and Tuition

Annual Registration Fee: \$25 or \$45 for Families

Referral Program

BalletCNJ's Referral Program grants \$50.00 off tuition for every student referred who registers for classes.

Referral Program Guidelines

- Referred students must be fully registered for classes before any discount is applied.
- Referred students must not be on the same tuition statement. They must be on a separate bill. (i.e. siblings)
- Open/Adult students are not considered referred students.
- Students may be referred during the course of the school year; however, discounts will apply during the next billing cycle.
- Make sure referred student informs the school you have referred them!

Class Make Up Policy

BalletCNJ strongly suggests that students keep up with their training; however, we also understand students may have very demanding schedules. In case of absence from class, students will be able to make up any missed classes through the year in a class of appropriate level and/or during the scheduled make-up week, which is not included in the weeks of training. If students have any medical condition excusable by a doctor, they will be permitted to miss class with make-up class to follow whenever possible. Students are responsible for communicating absences, keeping track of missed classes and make up times to Directors and Teachers.

Cancellation Policy

Any student that wishes to cancel the year round program prior to its completion is required to give a 30 day notice. If a student wishes to cancel/drop a class, there will be a \$25.00 cancelation fee.
